Touch and feel old house hold items



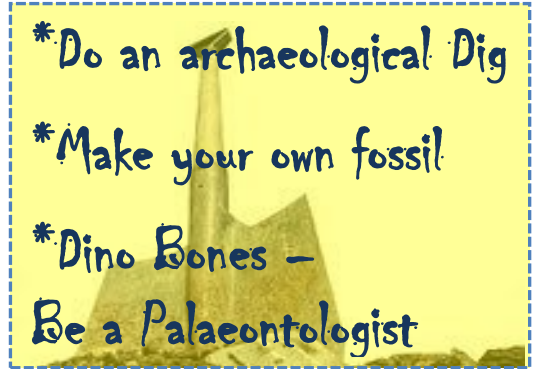
3. Digging Up The past
